- small farms treated as backward and unproductive, and thus constituting an obstacle to the development of the world economy
- small farms perform a number of social and environmental functions, hence they are crucial for long-term development

Agriculture in Poland in the XXI century

- high, seventh place in the European Union in terms of agricultural production volume
- high, positive balance of foreign trade in food (almost EUR 10 billion in 2018)
 - accession to the EU
 - inflow of foreign investment (foreign corporations)
 - "backwardness" rent more traditional food
 - modernization of Polish food factories

BUT

 disparity of agricultural to non-agricultural income, although in recent years lower as a result of the inflow of European funds, mainly the Common Agricultural Policy

Definition of small farm in Poland

- There is no clear definition of a small farm
- Most commonly used criteria:
 - physical farm area (5 or 10 ha of UAA)
 - economic size standard output (8 or 15 thousand SO)
 - labor input small farms consumes ca. 0.5-2 AWU annualy
 - self-consumption a small farm uses most of its own production for self-consumption
 - formal criterion for direct support EUR 1,250

The role of small farms

- due to the number of small farms in Poland, they are the basis for an agrarian structure and remain an important player in the field of food production
- they are a guarantee of maintaining many families in rural areas
- multi-functional character activities for the benefit of the local community and the natural environment

Benefits of small farm activities

- diversification plant and animal production, landscape, culture, tradition;
- responsible management of natural resources, water, forests, maintaining animal welfare;
- creating jobs in the countryside, building social ties,
- combining work and life for the family
- providing relatively cheap food produced in a more traditional way, and thus tastier and healthier



Policy towards small farms in Poland (1)

4 groups of support:

- 1. development of agricultural production
- 2. diversification of activities
- 3. farm/land transfer to another farmer
- 4. administrative facilities







Policy towards small farms in Poland (2)

- 1. Development of agricultural production
- specially addressed action "Restructuring of small farms", launched under the Rural Development Program 2014-2020.
- the aid is granted for a farm with an economic size of up to 6,000. euro SO
- for restructuring towards the production of agricultural products, preparation for sale/direct sale or processing of agricultural products

Policy towards small farms in Poland (3)

2. Diversification of activities

funds for starting non-agricultural activities (RDP 2014-2020

3. Farm/land transfer to another farmer

- special payment to small farms (RDP 2014-2020)
- for farmers who permanently transfer their farm to another farmer
- the transferee undertakes to carry out agricultural activity for a period of at least 5 years

Policy towards small farms in Poland (4)

4. Administrative facilities

- creation of a simplified system of direct payments in the first pillar of the CAP (from 2015)
- covers farmers who received direct payments of no more than EUR 1,250 per year (having a farm of approximately 5-6 ha of UAA).
- simplification means less restrictive criteria for crosscompliance and greening of direct payments
